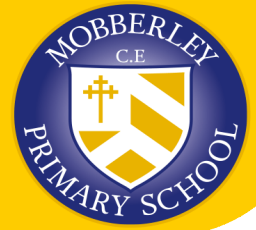

Dear Parent / Carer,

The start of the school year is always a bit nervy for pupils finding their way in their new classes and parents wondering how they are getting on. This is particularly so for the parents of our new reception pupils – I know this through personal experience, as I have a little boy of my own starting his reception class over in Stockport. When you hand your child over, it is a leap of trust in a school. I will say that we are fortunate to have staff who care deeply about every child and will go out of their way to ensure each child has what they need.

Just by walking through the school you can see that the children have settled very well. Classes are very calm and purposeful. Playtimes are happy and cheerful. The conditions are right for a successful year ahead.

Next Tuesday 17th September will be our start of year service in St Wilfrid's Church led by Fr Ian. Although space is at a premium when the whole school attends church, parents are always welcome to join us. I hope you will find this useful.

This year I would kindly request that all parents are particularly mindful of arriving on time for school. Lateness was an ongoing issue during the summer term with around 12 families regularly arriving after the gate had closed which does disrupt learning for each of the classes. **Please arrive before 8.55am.** Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

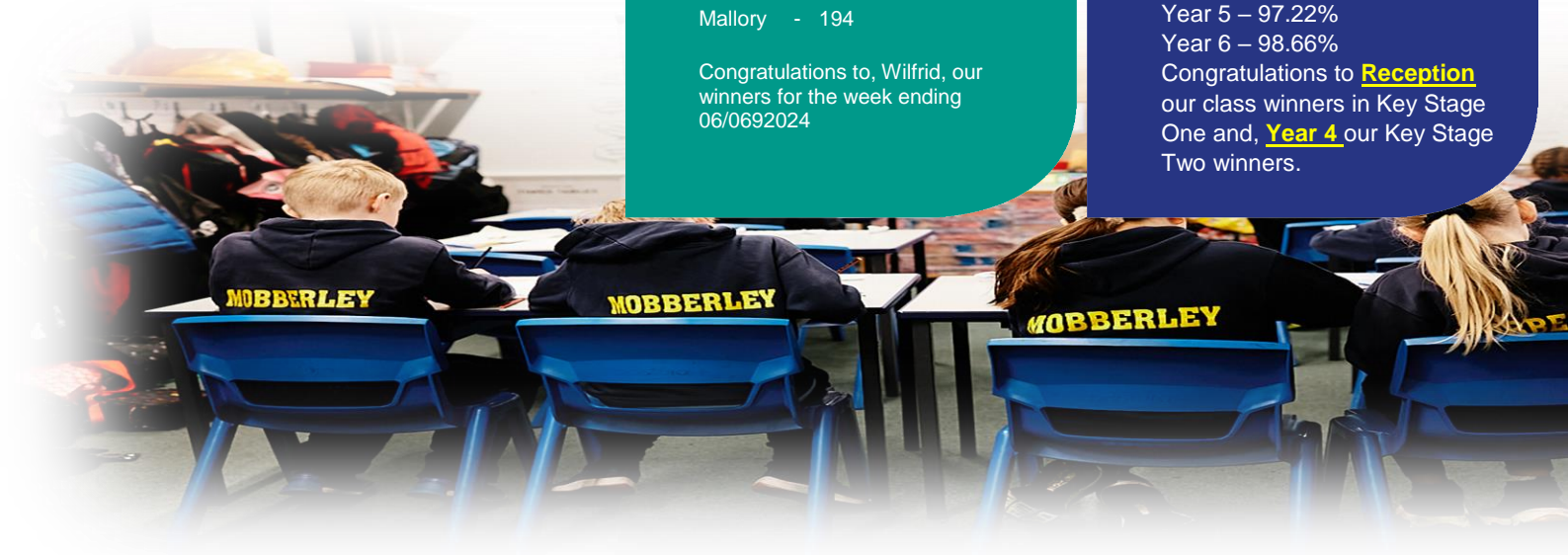
