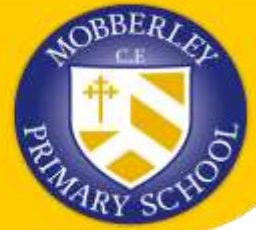


# MOBBERLEY NEWSLETTER

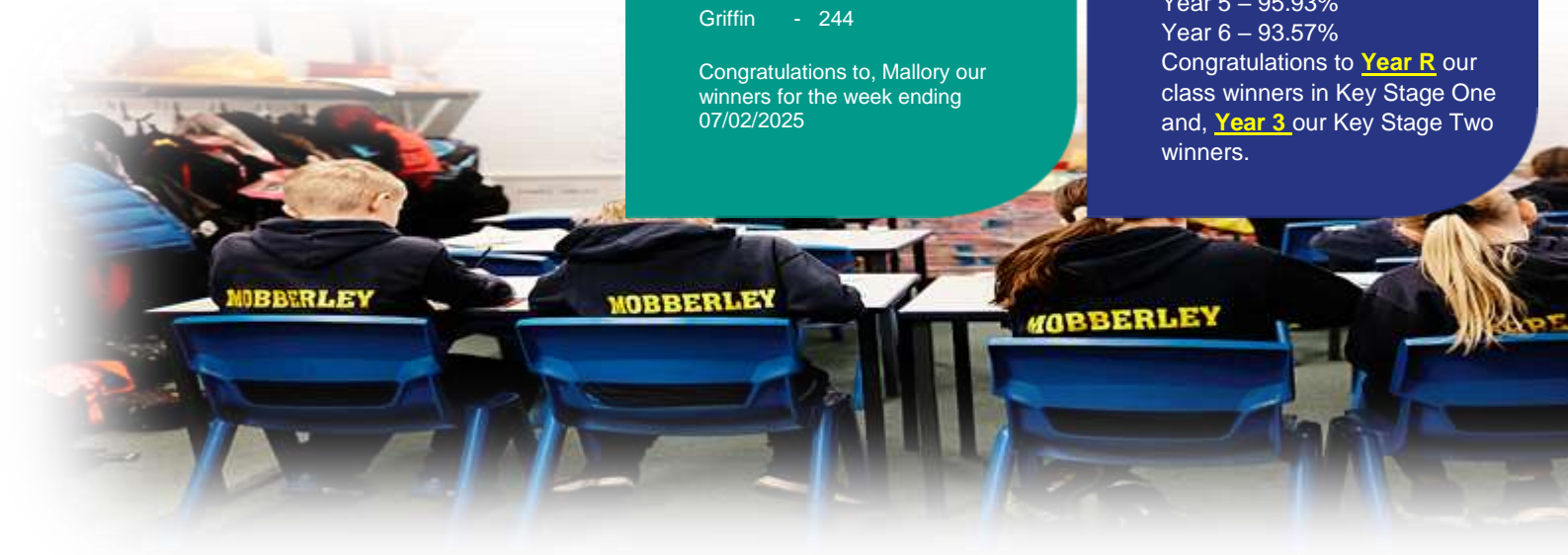
