For many, this will be the first set of formal examinations that they have undertaken and it is only natural to be a little nervous. 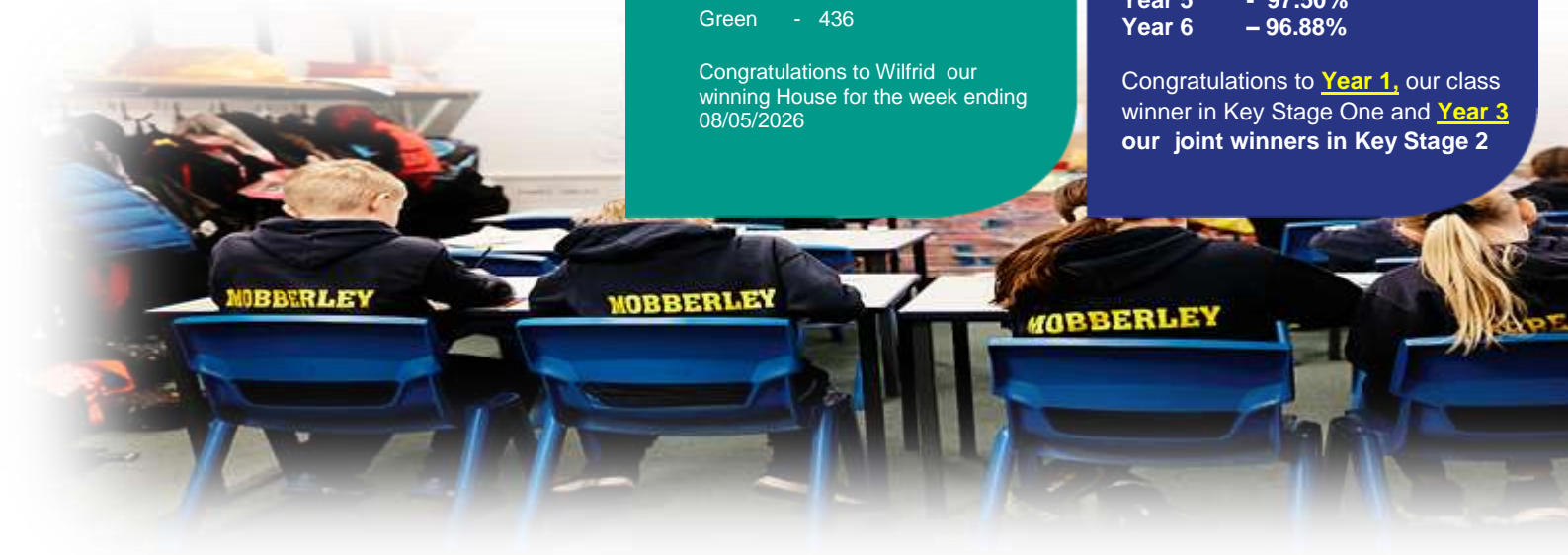
